YORLMC Roadshows

Message from NY Branch Chair Dr Sally Tyrer

Each Spring YORLMC hosts a series of locality roadshows to update GPs and practice managers on changes to the GP contract. This year, these roadshows will be held via Zoom with a choice of a late afternoon or evening session.

These roadshows will be hosted by YORLMC Medical Secretary Dr Brian McGregor and will include an update on changes to the GP contract 2021-22. The significant increases in funding planned for 2021/22 will take place but there will be minimal contractual changes for practices from April 2021 and some previous agreements will be delayed. This is to give practices support and stability through the continued pandemic and whilst practices are playing a significant role in the COVID-19 vaccination programme. There's more detail on the <u>BMA website</u> and the roadshows will be an opportunity to hear direct from Brian about the implications of these changes, and ask him your questions.

Brian will also provide the latest news on NHSE/I proposals to make ICSs (Integrated Care Systems) statutory bodies. These proposals could have a dramatic effect on the healthcare landscape and significantly alter the role of CCGs. The <u>BMA</u> and <u>YORLMC</u> have each responded to the engagement exercise and the roadshow will be a chance to hear more about the impact of these possible changes and next steps.
