ICS consultation and the White Paper

The Government has published a white paper on plans to reform the NHS, these include proposals to make ICSs statutory and to make major changes to the way services are procured. The proposals set out that GPs will be one of the few required members of the ICS leadership, and that there will be a lot of flexibility around how place level (likely to be former CCG) working is organised and works. There is a key role for LMCs to engage in these proposals for change and to help shape outcomes. YORLMC will be working to ensure that the views of local GPs are sought, their interests represented and that any outcomes and significant developments are communicated and shared.

GPM*plus*

YORLMC is pleased to announce the launch of GPM*plus*. GPM*plus* is a free mentoring service which can be accessed by all GPs including trainee, salaried, locum and returning GPs, working in the LMC catchment areas of YORLMC, Leeds, Calderdale, Kirklees, Humberside and Wakefield. Access to COVID vaccinations

There are a number of potential routes to be vaccinated as a sessional GP:

- via a PCN if you are working/or have a working relationship with one of the constituent member practices of that PCN
- via a GP federation employing sessional GP's
- via your own GP practice the default position in many cases
- via mass vaccination sites
- via Trust hospital hubs if you are working there/or have a working relationship with a trust team

Practices are encouraged to liaise with local system partners to ensure that any staff who have not yet been offered a vaccine are offered one, including any locum GPs they are in regular contact with, as soon as practically possible.



DDRB pay award

The BMA has received reports that some salaried GPs are struggling to get their 2.8% pay lift, as recommended by DDRB and approved by the government, despite being entitled to it. There is a contractual requirement to implement this pay lift for salaried GPs employed on the BMA model contract.

If you are a salaried GP struggling to obtain the pay lift, even after having a conversation about the matter with your practice manager, you may wish to send a formal letter. The <u>BMA DDRB template letter</u> can be adapted to reflect your circumstances. Please <u>get in touch with the BMA</u> if you need further assistance in this area.
