Action from YORLMC officers



YORLMC officers meet regularly with other organisations to take up particular issues, catch up on developments and maintain good relationships and open communications. Just some of the recent meetings attended by YORLMC officers include:

- Meeting with the Bradford hospital midwife team, 17 March.
 Matters discussed included requests from midwives for GPs to prescribe (copy of the midwives' anaemia protocol is available from YORLMC if required) and analgesia for patients who have early discharge post Caesarean section.
- On 7 April, YORLMC officers met with the community mental health team at Bradford District Care Trust to talk about services for patients with eating disorders. The letter at <u>Appendix 1</u> was shared with all GPs and practice managers shortly after this meeting with an update.
- A meeting on 15 April to discuss referrals to the adult autism service, particularly about the number of referrals rejected and GP concerns about referral form (it is lengthy and not necessarily the type of information that the GP may know).
- A catch up with the Public Health team at Bradford Council, 24
 April, for discussions about the services commissioned by the council.
- Regular liaison with other local representative organisations (pharmacy, opticians and dentists) – the latest meeting took place on 28 April.




