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Action from YORLMC officers

YORLMC officers meet regularly with other organisations to take up particular issues, catch up on developments and maintain good relationships and open communications.

Over the last few weeks, the YORLMC team has been in regular contact with the CCG and the Bradford midwife team about a range of matters raised by local GPs and practices – please see a summary of these discussions below:

Prescribing of injectable Cyclizine in primary care

There is no protocol for this and no plans to introduce one. This would be an unreasonable request and far too onerous to deal with in primary care - especially given the current level of demand. Cyclizine in the community should be oral, if requiring more than this then the day unit should be dealing with this.

Pethidine

Prescription of pethidine by GPs is not essential, and the risks outweigh any potential benefits.

Prescribing of low molecular weight heparin

There is no protocol or agreement for GPs to do this on behalf of midwives.

Referrals to EPAU

Patients cannot self refer to the EPAU – practices should not give the EPAU number to patients. EPAU referrals should be from primary care via the GP/ANP/PA.

Community midwife clinics

The midwife team is now allowing partners into community clinics with the pregnant patient, though due to social distancing this may be difficult in some practice premises.

YORLMC representatives also attend a range of Act as One workstreams, ICS meetings, the local IT Reference Group and meet regularly with senior CCG representatives.

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
