NHSE are funding a good number of places on the programme. The Catalyst team does recommend that you register as soon as possible so that they can confirm your place and discuss your bursary application.

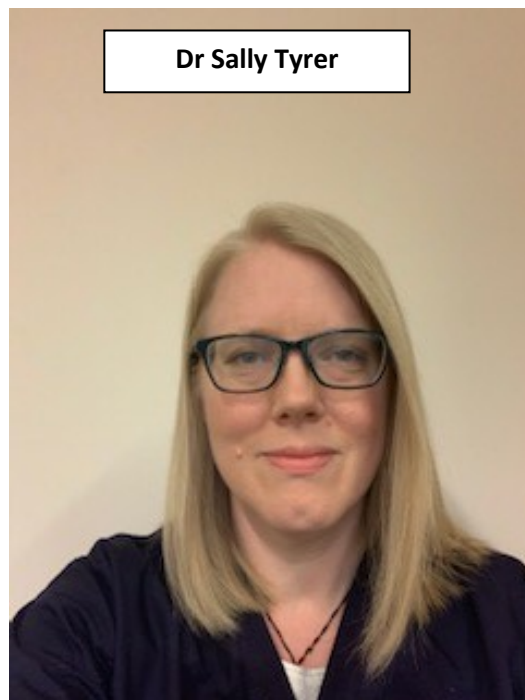

As you will appreciate, services are constantly adjusting to take into account changes to national guidance and local needs.

Changes to payment process—Drug misuse shared care services, North Yorkshire

The North Yorkshire Public Health Team recently contacted practices (via PharmOutcomes/ Outcomes4Health) that are commissioned to deliver the drug misuse shared care service to confirm a change to the annual patient payment process. Practices will no longer be required to submit an annual patient claim in order to receive payment, this will now be completed on behalf of contracted practices by the Recovery Co-ordinator from North Yorkshire Horizons who provides shared care support. Practices will continue to receive a payment of £369.09 per patient per year for all patients that the Recovery Co-ordinator is supporting. Practices will also continue to receive an annual payment (£1021.57) automatically each year, to support the designated clinician to maintain their CPD and associated competence.
