All about you survey results

Practice Managers are vital to the success of general practice. YORLMC received funding from Bradford District and Craven CCG to support work to look at Practice Managers' Health & Wellbeing and, as the first step in this project, surveyed all Practice Managers across Bradford, Airedale, Wharfedale & Craven about their roles and what support they need.

75 per cent of Practice Managers replied – thank you very much to everyone who took the time to give us their views.

The next stage of the project is to develop focus groups to look further into the key areas that were raised in the survey. The focus groups will be made up of representatives from Practice Managers, GPs, commissioners and YORLMC. The project board will shortly be finalising the topics for the focus groups to discuss, and we aim to commence the focus group meetings in October. We will be in touch with Practice Managers again in the next few weeks with more details about the focus groups, including dates, and to request expressions of interest from Practice Managers who would like to take part.


