PRACTICE MANAGER APPRAISALS

At the end of February we heard that we were to receive funding from NHS England via a pilot scheme that was being run by our colleagues at Wessex LMCs. The scheme is based around supporting and developing practice managers through peer appraisals. We asked for applications from managers who felt that they would like to be trained as an appraiser and for them to be available for the training in 6 days time. We also asked for managers to come forward who wanted to have an appraisal performed by one of the trained appraisers.

Despite the tight deadlines we were overwhelmed with the amount of managers who were willing to take part both as an appraiser and as an appraisee. There is an obvious desire for this kind of support to be available for practice managers and we hope to find further opportunities to continue this work in the future.
