We have now completed 3 of the 4 GP roadshows across North Yorkshire. These have been well attended and as well as updating practices on the GP Contract and the GP Forward view, attendees found out more about the increasing range of services provided by YORLMC. All of these topics provided an excellent forum for discussion. We are pleased to have received excellent roadshow feedback and YORLMC will continue to update practices regularly on progress against all workstreams of the GPFV.

Last week YORLMC officers attended a second BMA conference that supports the roll out of the GPFV on new ways of managing workload. YORLMC is now working to bring examples of best practice back locally, linking to the emerging funding streams. YORLMC continues to work with our local CCGs as they face increasing financial challenge this year. We will ensure the resources promised to stabilise and transform general practice, in particularly the £3 per head <u>Practice Transformational Support Scheme</u>, are not lost or diverted. Without a strong local general practice, local health economies will only struggle further and we believe stabilisation and investment must precede any transfer of workload or expansion of services.

NHS England Standard Hospital Contract guidance 2017-2019

Please see the entry in the <u>April edition of YORLMC news</u> on the new NHS standard contract. The new contract for secondary care trusts came into force on 1 April 2017 and there are a number of changes affecting the interface between secondary and primary care which are aimed at reducing the transfer of work to primary care and GPs.

The newsletter entry highlights who practices are to report breaches to and also provides a link to the BMA website that gives advice about the new changes for this year and has new template letters to support reporting breaches directly back to the hospital concerned.
