



Bradford & Airedale Branch Report

Feedback on General Practice Forward View (GPFV) survey

Practice Managers will have received an email in May from YORLMC inviting their views on the impact of the GPFV on its one year anniversary. Thank you very much to those who responded, a copy of the results is below. This sample shows that, whilst some practices have seen benefit from the GPFV, the majority have not. We will use these results in our ongoing work with local commissioners to ensure that funding promised reaches the front line.
