SUPERVISING CLINICAL COLLEAGUES

Increases in the size of practices and changes in the workforce means that there is an increased need for clinicians to supervise other clinicians. For example, nurses supervising other nurses or healthcare assistants; GPs supervising salaried GPs, nurses and pharmacists. This may be done through formal supervision sessions but also on an

informal day to day basis. This course is designed for primary care clinicians to enhance their skills in supervising colleagues. Dates are now available to book on the [website](#).

FUNDING

You will have seen the statement released from PHE recently regarding the provision of Cytology and Vacc & Imms training, specifically the following statement..

"There is also a progressive move towards a more market-based model for the provision of and access to this training, which is increasingly seen as an employer responsibility. In particular, the funding of update training for both cervical sample takers and immunisers is now regarded by HEE as an employer responsibility."

Whilst this is a new direction for Yorkshire & Humber, for some areas of the country this has always been the case so there is a move to standardise the funding across Health Education England.

As it currently stands, basic training for Cytology and Vacc & Imms will still be provided by the various Universities. Update training for cytology is now accessed via e-learning. Update training for Vacc & Imms may still be provided by some Universities but there will be a charge.
