Message from Steve Patterson BA Branch Chair

As we head into autumn, here are just a few of the projects YORLMC is currently working on.

Hopefully the staggered flu deliveries over September, October and November will go smoothly. In conjunction with Community Pharmacy West Yorkshire (the Local Pharmaceutical Committee) we are encouraging practices to work collaboratively with their local pharmacists to increase uptake.

In City and Districts the Standard Access Scheme piece of work on consultations is due to be completed by practices by the end of September. We've also been in discussion about a better way of recording shared care medication to reduce practices workload.

We meet regularly with senior representatives from Bradford Teaching Hospital NHS Foundation Trust and Bradford District Care Trust. These meetings are an opportunity for both sides to raise concerns and for useful discussion on how to resolve problems. There is regular liaison with Airedale NHS Foundation Trust through their attendance at YORLMC AWC Division meetings. Recent matters discussed include:

- Problems with EPR discharge summaries.
- Duration of Med3s
- Letters not sent to the referring GP

'Promoting positive mental health and preventing burnout in our GP workforce' Book now for 3 October workshop

GPs (including GPRs) across Bradford, Airedale, Wharfedale & Craven are invited to attend a workshop on 'Promoting positive mental health and preventing burnout in our GP workforce'. This event is supported by YORLMC and the Bradford District and Craven Integrated Workforce Programme and will take place on the evening of 3 October.

Emergency hormonal contraception

GPs and practices will be aware that from 1 April 2018, Bradford Metropolitan District Council made changes to the emergency hormonal contraception service, available at certain pharmacies. Under these changes, the service is now free of charge only to those patients under 20 years (previously the service was available free to patients under 25 years).

Emergency hormonal contraception continues to be available free of charge at Locala. YORLMC has raised concerns that the location of Locala means that these services are hard to access for some patients.

YORLMC Division Meetings - GPs and Practice Managers invited to attend
