YORLMC is now in discussions with YAS's Executive Medical Director and is due to hold a meeting to discuss this and other YAS related concerns later this month. We will keep practices informed of any developments.

The BMA has long standing agreements with funeral directors which advise an £82 fee for crematorium forms and 57.5p mileage rates. These are advised fees only and practices are not contractually obliged to adopt these fees.
