Primary Care Networks—new guidance

Following the issue of <u>further guidance</u> and the <u>Primary Care Networks DES</u> specification and <u>Network Agreement</u>, further meetings across North Yorkshire & York have been jointly organised by YORLMC and NYY CCGs to support practices in ensuring the emerging PCNs are successful and compliant in submitting their bids by 15 May 2019. YORLMC has developed a dedicated PCN guidance webpage which can be accessed <u>here</u>. Alongside this work YORLMC is also working with CCGs and STP colleagues to ensure we develop robust GP representation, feeding in the voice of PCNs and their Clinical Directors and led by YORLMC at place and system level as Integrated Care Systems emerge.

North Yorkshire Team attend LMC UK Conference

North Yorkshire LMC sent a team of Officers and Members of YORLMC to the LMC UK Conference on 19 and 20 March 2019 to help set GPC UK policy for the coming year.
